Context:

Under the overall supervision of the Head of Office and direct supervision of the Project Coordinator, the successful candidate will contribute to the successful implementation of the project “*Contributing to sustainable reintegration of victims of trafficking in persons in Albania*” implemented by IOM Tirana as part of the implementation of the Results Framework of the Government of Albania and United Nations Program of Cooperation (2017-2021). This project specifically is part of the UN Support under Outcome 2: Women, men, girls and boys, especially those from vulnerable groups, have access to inclusive, equitable and quality social services and benefit from increased investments for enhanced social cohesion in line with their rights through the financial support of the Swedish Government. The overall objective of the project is to contribute to the development and adoption of standards of social care for reintegration process of victims of trafficking in Albania as specifically elaborated in the “*Priorities and Action Plan for 2016-2017 in the area of anti-trafficking*”.

Core Functions / Responsibilities:

Supporting the International consultant in conducting, a desk review of the existing policy, institutional framework in Albania including “*Guidelines for implementation of the national standards of social care for trafficked persons or persons at risk of trafficking in residential centres*” and other relevant materials already developed;

2. Supporting the International consultant in identifying stakeholders and conduct interviews and meetings as needed;
3. Supporting the International consultant to develop a first draft of the document of “Standards of social care for reintegration process of victims of trafficking in Albania”;
4. Supporting the International consultant to incorporate and reflect regional and international expertise as guided by the IOM Regional Office in Vienna Expert during the process of establishing reintegration standards and ensure that the best international examples are reflected in the document developed for Albania;
5. Supporting the International consultant to present the document of “Standards of social care for reintegration process of victims of trafficking in Albania” in two validations round tables with stakeholders and partners in Tirana;
6. Supporting the International consultant to incorporate recommendations from the round tables and prepare the final document of “Standards of social care for reintegration process of victims of trafficking in Albania” to be handed over to the Albanian Authorities;
7. Support the international consultant with translations from Albanian in English as needed.
